Greenhouse whitewash



Summer is here, and the sun has a real bite to it. That greenhouse that was so cosy three months ago is now a sauna. Instead of encouraging early growth from your plants, it now threatens to boil them in their own juices.

The traditional way of reducing heat and light intensity in greenhouses is painting the exterior with Parasoline. In dry weather and under cloudless skies, Parasoline reduces light intensity in the greenhouse by up to 60%. As the season progresses, and autumn rains arrive, the greenhouse gradually returns to full transparency, and the final coating can be removed with a brush to prepare the greenhouse for winter and spring.

Gardensmart now has Parasoline available in 1.6 kg pails (sufficient for approximately 40 m²) and 20 kg bags (sufficient for approx 500 m²)
